Lynn Good is the former chair and chief executive officer of Duke Energy, one of America's largest energy holding companies. She retired effective April 2025. Under her leadership, Duke Energy focused on addressing rapidly growing energy needs and powering the modern economy, while maintaining the reliability, affordability and security customers depend on.



Good oversaw one of the largest regulated capital plans in the industry, investing in an energy transition that delivered value for Duke Energy's customers and shareholders. Before becoming CEO in 2013, Good served as Duke Energy's chief financial officer and earlier led the company's commercial energy businesses during its initial development of renewable energy projects.

Good currently serves on the boards of directors for Boeing, Foundation For The Carolinas, Morgan Stanley and New York City Ballet. She also serves on the Charlotte Executive Leadership Council and Bechtler Museum of Modern Art Advisory Council. Good holds Bachelor of Science degrees in systems analysis and accounting from Miami University in Oxford, Ohio. She and her husband, Brian, live in Charlotte.
