Assistant Dean of Student Life, Pro Bono Opportunities, and Belonging Campbell Law School

Regina Chavis is the Assistant Dean of Student Life, Pro Bono Opportunities, and Belonging at Campbell Law School in downtown Raleigh. Born in Washington D.C., Regina spent her early years in Maryland, before relocating to eastern North Carolina with her family. She attended North Carolina Central University where she obtained a Bachelor of Arts in English. After graduation, Regina returned to eastern North Carolina to teach. Although education was not Regina's original career path, it was a predestined assignment that prepared her for her current position. As an educator, Regina learned the importance of inclusion, came to understand the detriment of exclusion, and discovered the power of creating an inclusive environment. From the middle school classroom to the college classroom, teaching gave Regina the opportunity to build community within her classroom, while fostering a safe and collaborative learning environment where students were treated equitably and afforded opportunities to be successful. Regina worked in education for 20 years prior to receiving her law degree from Campbell University. After graduation she worked as an attorney with Legal Aid of North Carolina for three years, before returning to Campbell Law as an Assistant Dean.
