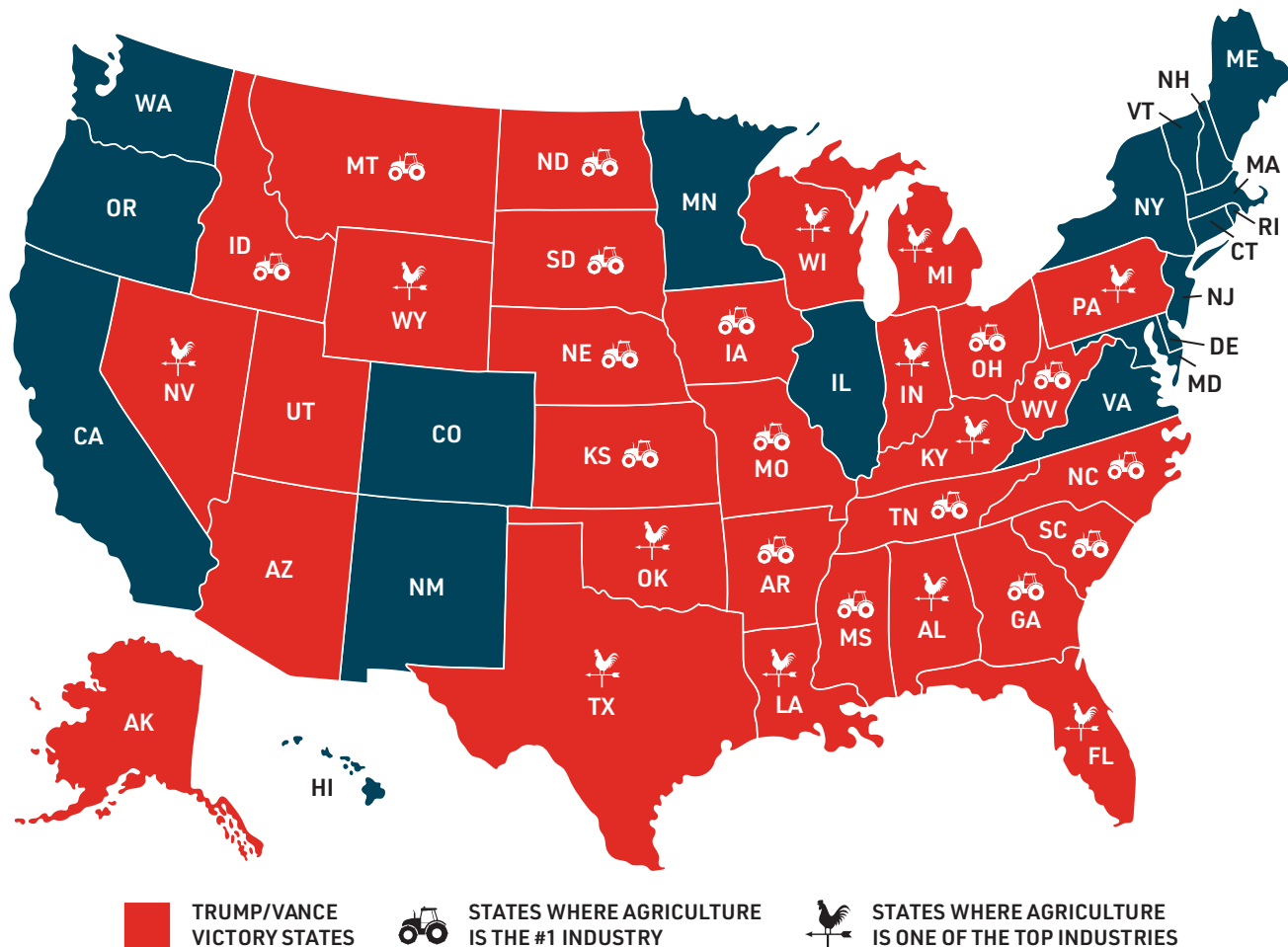


GROWING THE AG ECONOMY
