Dr. Bart Fischer currently serves as the Co-Director of the Agricultural & Food Policy Center at Texas A&M University, as AgriLife Associate Professor in the Department of Agricultural Economics, and as Senior Advisor for Federal Relations in the Office of the Vice Chancellor. Each spring he teaches agricultural and food policy to almost 200 undergraduate students.



Before joining the university in September 2019, he served for more than 8 years at the Committee on Agriculture in the U.S. House of Representatives, most recently as the Deputy Staff Director & Chief Economist under the leadership of Chairman K. Michael Conaway (TX-11). During his time with the Committee, he was involved in virtually every major agricultural policy development in Washington, D.C., including helping craft and pass the 2014 and 2018 Farm Bills.

Dr. Fischer holds bachelor's degrees from Oklahoma State University, a master's degree from Cambridge University, and a Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics from Texas A&M University. He is the 5th generation to be raised on his family's wheat, cotton, and cattle operation in Southwest Oklahoma, where he continues to be actively involved.
