Erik Hall is the Director of Plant Engineering, Procurement and Construction, Distributed Energy Resource (DER) Fleet, and Jointly Owned Resources at North Carolina's Electric Cooperatives. In this role, he provides strategic and technical leadership for large-scale generation development, DER operations and optimization, and the management of jointly owned nuclear and combined-cycle assets.

Erik leads cross-functional teams responsible for delivering reliable, affordable, and resilient energy solutions that support the evolving needs of the 2.8 million North Carolinians served by the state's electric cooperatives. His work spans the full asset lifecycle—from design and construction to operations, maintenance, and continuous improvement—at a time of rapid change in the energy industry.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering and an MBA from the Georgia Institute of Technology. Prior to joining North Carolina's Electric Cooperatives, Erik served 12 years as a nuclear submarine officer in the U.S. Navy and later as Director of Energy Management at North Carolina State University.
