Dr. Rob Handfield is the Bank of America University Distinguished Professor of Supply Chain Management at North Carolina State University, and Executive Director of the Supply Chain Resource Cooperative (<http://scm.ncsu.edu/>). Handfield is considered a thought leader in the field of supply chain management and has extensive knowledge in the fields of sourcing, supply market intelligence, and supply chain resilience. Handfield has published more than 150 peer reviewed journal articles and is regularly quoted in global news media such as the *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, *LA Times*, *Bloomberg*, *NPR*, *Washington Post*, *the Financial Times*, *Fox Business News*, and *CNN*. He served on the Joint Acquisition Task Force during COVID which led to published articles on the shortages of PPE in the *Harvard Business Review* and the *Milbank Quarterly Journal* and led a NIIMBL research team studying distribution of test kits during the pandemic. He was also invited to serve on the Biden White House Counsel of Economic Advisors in January 2022 and has worked with many companies through the Supply Chain Resource Cooperative for several years.
