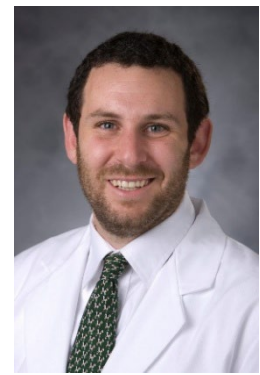

Gary Maslow, MD, MPH, is the Chief of the Division of Child and Family Mental Health and Community Psychiatry in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Duke University School of Medicine. He is a Gorrell Family Distinguished Professor in Children's Psychiatry and a Professor of Pediatrics, and he serves as the Co-PI of the North Carolina Psychiatry Access Line. He obtained his medical degree from Dartmouth College and completed a Triple Board Residency in Pediatrics, Psychiatry, and Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Brown University.



Dr. Maslow's clinical and research interests include helping children with chronic illness adapt to their diagnosis, supporting adolescents with chronic illness transition into adulthood, and promoting positive youth development and quality of life. His work aims to bridge the gap between clinical practice and research to create interventions that can be deployed broadly to support the successful development of youth and improve the services provided to these youth by the broader healthcare system.
