Tony is a senior biopharmaceutical professional with 27 years of experience in global biologics operations, gene therapy, commercial development, business development, contract manufacturing operations, building successful teams, project management, quality requirements, and biologics product development in a multi-product environment. He joined Pfizer in 2011.

Tony was appointed the Site Leader for Pfizer Sanford in 2018, bringing him to the US for the first time. He arrived in Sanford during a time of growth and expansion, primarily due to the new Gene Therapy facility.

Previously, Tony spent 7 years in Australia as the Site Leader at Pfizer Adelaide and was responsible for completing a \$21 million construction project to upgrade the cGMP manufacturing facility on time and under budget for the commercialization of a Biosimilar product. Achieving a strong culture was a key success while Tony led the site and was demonstrated in 2017 when he managed the change management and communications strategy for Pfizer's exit from the site. Colleague morale remained high and the site milestones were achieved as planned during the exit process. Prior to Pfizer, Tony spent 17 years in Contract Manufacturing Organizations in the UK. Tony has a BSc in Physiology & Biochemistry and a Doctorate in Autoimmunity.
