Dr. Holly Myers is the Dean of Health Sciences and has worked at Davidson-Davie Community College since 2004. At Davidson-Davie she has taught Biology courses for both career technical and college transfer students, led a state-wide curriculum redesign program for the NC Community College System, and served as an academic administrator for health science programs. As Dean of Health Sciences, she strives to ensure equitable access to health science programs and foster partnerships between education and the healthcare workforce.



In 2020 she created North Carolina's first nursing-based apprenticeship program to help mitigate workforce shortages, expanding the program to include allied health professions in 2022 and creating the largest healthcare apprenticeship in North Carolina at the time. She holds a B.A. from Catawba College in Biology, M.S. from Wake Forest University in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, and Ph.D. from Walden University in Public Health with a concentration in Epidemiology, where her graduate research focused on social and environmental risk factors for pancreatic cancers in North Carolina.
