## Senator Vickie Sawyer (NC-37)

In January 2023, Senator Vickie Sawyer started serving as Senator to the 37th District of North Carolina, representing Iredell County and a portion of Mecklenburg County. Senator Sawyer previously served as Senator to the 34th Senate District of North Carolina in representation of Iredell and Yadkin Counties. Prior to serving the 34th district, Senator Sawyer was appointed in August 2018 to represent the 44th Senate district of North Carolina after Republican activists picked her to complete the two-year term of Senator David Curtis.



Senator Sawyer serves as a Co-Chair of the Senate Transportation Committee and as a Co-Chair of the Senate Transportation Appropriations Committee in the North Carolina General Assembly. She also serves on the Senate Finance, Commerce & Insurance, Rules, and Budget Committees. Additionally, Sawyer is the founder of the NC TEN Commission which brings together leaders in the transportation industry in an effort to find solutions to fund the future of transportation in North Carolina. The National Conference of Insurance Legislators announced Senator Sawyer as Vice Chair of Property and Casualty Insurance.
