Nicole M. Winget is the Assistant Dean for Student Life and Support for Adult and Online Education and the military campus Director. She is also an instructor in the Homeland Security and Criminal Justice programs at Campbell University. Since joining Campbell in the spring of 2015, she has been an active member of the Campbell family and serves in additional roles such as mock trial coach and fitness instructor. She is on the boards of the Fayetteville Military Affairs Council, the Council for Military and College Educators, and the National Association of Institutions for Military Education Services.



She graduated from Ohio Northern University College of Law in 2009 and practiced law in Ohio, focusing on Criminal Defense and Trial Advocacy. While a lawyer, Nicole also taught at Ohio Northern University, Ohio State University, and Rhodes State College.
