The chance came to move to Fox 46 Charlotte. I joined the Good Day Charlotte team as a weekend anchor and reporter. You can now catch me Monday through Friday, co-anchoring Good Day Charlotte, from 4:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. When I'm not working I love to explore Charlotte and am involved with the Junior League of Charlotte.

This year I'm volunteering at Second Harvest Food Bank. I'm quickly learning to love the Panthers and the Hornets.
